

## Adriano Cattaneo, MD, MSc

Adriano Cattaneo is Consultant Epidemiologist and Co-ordinator of the Unit for Health Services Research and International Health, Institute of Child Health "IRCCS Burlo Garofolo", Trieste, Italy, a WHO Collaborating Centre for Maternal and Child Health. He holds an MD degree from the University of Padova and an MSc degree from the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. He has spent most of his professional career in developing countries, including four years as medical officer with the WHO. He is author and co-author of about 150 publications in scientific journals, books and conference proceedings, member of the Italian Society of Epidemiology, and Lecturer in Epidemiology and International Health at the Universities of Trieste, Padova and Brescia. He is fluent in English, French, Spanish and Portuguese. As project coordinator of an EU-funded project, he played an important role in the development of the document "Protection, promotion and support of breastfeeding in Europe: a Blueprint for Action." Currently he is coordinating an EU project to pilot test the usefulness of the Blueprint for Action for the development of national breastfeeding programmes and a project for the prevention of overweight and obesity in preschool and school children in two regions of Italy.
