

## ***FHI360-UNC Public Health Fellowship Program***

Family Health International 360 (FHI360), in partnership with the Office of Global Health (OGH) in the UNC Gillings School of Global Public Health is offering a fellowship program for current or prospective doctoral students and second-year master's students. FHI360's mission is to improve lives worldwide by addressing complex public health issues through research, education and services. In addition to offices in the US, FHI360 operates in Africa, Asia, Latin America and the Caribbean. Since its founding in 1971, FHI360 has conducted clinical research in more than 95 countries utilizing greater than 1,000 sites. ### ***Opportunity Awaits You!***

This exciting fellowship program provides you with the opportunity to work with FHI360's world-renowned researchers in global health topics such as, HIV/AIDS and other infectious diseases, reproductive, maternal and adolescent health. As a fellow, you will have hands-on learning experiences that will expand your research skills as well as make important contributions to specific research studies. It is estimated that you will work at FHI360 20 hours weekly.

### ***Benefits***

This one-year fellowship will provide you with in-state tuition support (at the UNC Gillings School of Global Public Health), a stipend of \$18,000 (\$14,000 for academic year, \$4,000 for summer), and university fees and health insurance. Your assigned project has the potential to provide you with the basis for your dissertation or master's thesis.

### ***Application Process and Eligibility***

Eligible candidates are current doctoral students and second-year master's students enrolled in UNC's public health school. Prospective doctoral students may apply for the FHI360-UNC Fellowship.

All interested individuals will need to complete and submit the application form and required documents to the OGH. Required documents are listed in the application form. If you are an out-of-state student, current or applying for admission to the UNC Gillings School of Global Public Health, you will need to alert your department that you are applying for the FHI360-UNC Fellowship. Your department will need to provide a tuition remission if you are awarded the Fellowship.

A committee representing faculty from the UNC Gillings School of Global Public Health will review the applications. FHI360 will review all applications and schedule interviews with selected applicants.

Applications will be due to the OGH January 13, 2012. FHI360 will notify awardees by April 1, 2012.
