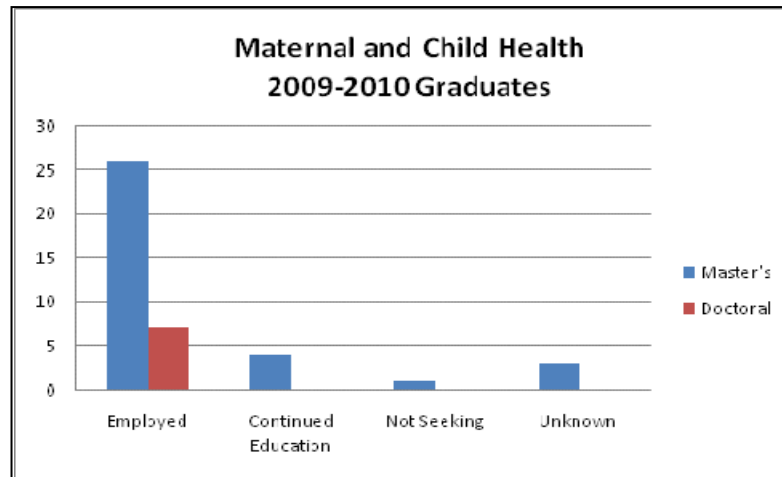


## Destinations of Maternal and Child Health Graduates, 2009-2010

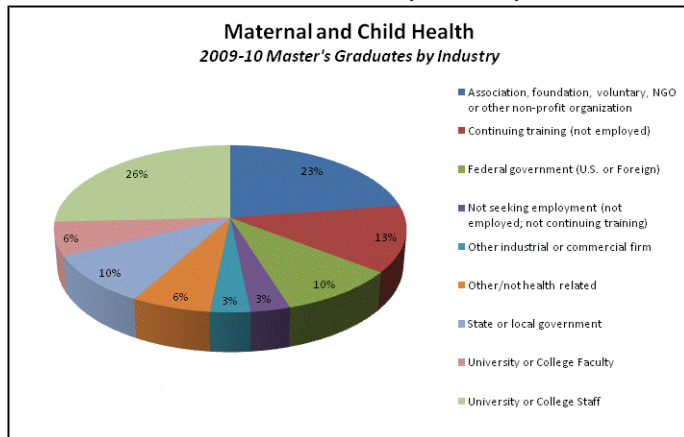

 2009-10 Maternal and Child Health Graduate Response Rate (38/41) = 93%

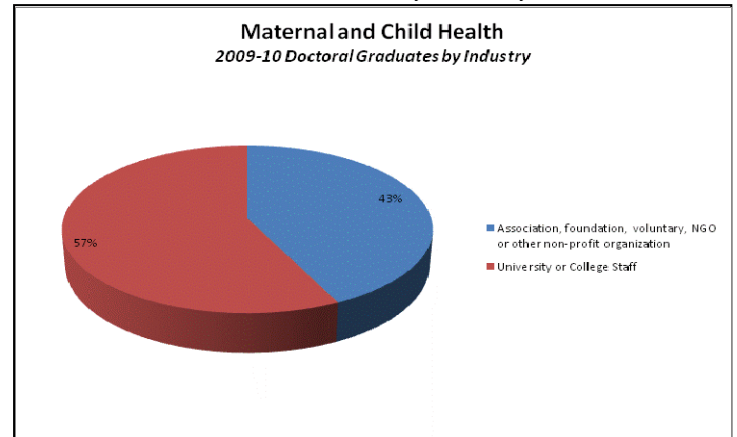
*Chart 1 – Destinations of Graduates*
